Introduction

- NHRC has the mandate to promote and protect human rights in Nigeria.
- NHRC has the powers to monitor, investigate and report human rights violations in Nigeria.
- Since January 2024, NHRC in partnership with UNDP, OHCHR and GANHRI has produced monthly dashboard on human rights situation.
- The Dashboards contain data from complaints lodged at the NHRC 38 offices across Nigeria and human rights violations monitored through NHRC Human Rights Observatory.


General Human Rights Situation

- Human rights complaints to the NHRC continue to be on the high.
- Mass casualty events recorded in food distribution events across Nigeria.
- Mass killings and abductions in the North West and North Central
- Killings of law enforcement and members of the Armed Forces
- Rise in cases of sexual violence against children and child abandonment
- The resurgence of terrorism in the North West through the Lakawura sect.


NHRC December 2024 Human Rights Complaints

 - Over 10% decrease in complaints


December 2024 Complaints Across Geo-Political Zones




December 2024 Thematic Human Rights Complaints

 Over 70 people lost their lives in stampedes in three incidents in Oyo, Anambra and the FCT.


Deaths by Accidents

- 81 Deaths by motor and boat accidents:
 - Boat Accident on River Benue 26 deaths
 - Road accidents 55 deaths

Extra-judicial killings

- Police
 - Police officer kills teenage boy over fireworks in Delta State.
 - 35 year old Jimoh Abdulqadir tortured to death in Kwara State.
- Military
 - Bombing of civilians in Sokoto State
 - Soldier stabbed a tricycle operator to death in Jos, Plateau State









Mass killings and abductions by state and non-state actors

Violation of the three freedoms: Speech, Assembly and Association.


Economic, social and cultural rights: Hunger, Health and Education

Law Enforcement and Security-Related Violations: Arrests and prolonged detention.




Jan-Dec 2024 Complaints Across Geo-Political Zones




Jan-Dec 2024 Complaints Across Geo-Political Zones (N)




Jan-Dec 2024 Complaints Across Geo-Political Zones (%)




Jan.-Dec. 2024 Sexual & Gender Based Violence








Kidnappings Across Geo-Political Zones



Kidnappings Across Geo-Political Zones (%)










